Depot of the old Central of Georgia Railway.

Savannah History Museum takes guests on a journey through time from 1733 to the present. Visitors will learn about the history of Savannah beginning with the Native Americans living in the area, Savannah's role in the American Revolution, technological development of the cotton gin and railroad and the impact of the Civil War on Savannah. Unique exhibits include a 1902 Crestmobile, a car that pre-dates the Ford Model A and Johnny Mercer's Oscar and Grammy awards.\*Additional time at the end of your tour allows for a restroom break and a visit to the gift shop. 10:30am Old Savannah Trolley Tour. BRINGING SAVANNAH'S HISTORY TO LIFE! Bringing Savannah's History to Life is not just a slogan.... it's a promise. Along with uniquely personal descriptions of Savannah's rich and spellbinding history, actual historical reenactors appear from time to time, boarding and walking the aisles of your trolley. Founded in 1733, Savannah is one of America's finest preserved cities and considered a jewel of the south, where all 2.2 square miles of the Historic District is a National Urban Historic Landmark District. You will enjoy a comprehensive, completely narrated; guided tour along cobblestone paved streets beneath moss-draped oaks and experience the "Old South" with her stately mansions, beautiful squares, and romantic River Street. 12 Noon Tour ends at the Visitors Center. Free time for lunch on your own / 2 pm Meet your Guide for afternoon tour. 2:30 pm Visit The Cathedral Basilica of St. John the Baptist is an iconic symbol of Savannah, Georgia, gracing the skyline with its towering steeples. This church represents historically noteworthy architecture as well as over a century of faith and civic traditions in Savannah. 3 pm Tour the Andrew Low House Museum, 329 Abercorn St. 912-233-1828. Andrew Low commissioned New York architect John Norris to design and construct his house in 1848. Norris came to Savannah to design the Custom House on Bay Street and remained in Savannah to build many desirable residences with the latest in technology and luxury. The Italianate exterior features intricate cast iron railings and side balconies contrasting with the smooth stucco brick walls. The well-proportioned rooms are decorated with elaborate plaster comices and carved woodwork. The delicate balance of exterior restraint and opulent interior resulted in an elegant villa for the family. The house remained in the family until the death of Andrew Low's daughter-in-law, Juliette Gordon Low, Founder of Girl Scouts of the USA. 4/4:30pm Tour ends. Guide departs. 5:00 PM Dinner at Paula Deen's lady and son's-102 W Congress St., Savannah, GA 31401/7:30 PM Arrive at the Historic Savanah Theatre for a performance / 10 PM Return to hotel after the show
