The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the one your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

Sept 21 Depart from Bethel Baptist Church 1004 Yorktown Rd., Yorktown, VA 23639 and travel to your overnight stop for lodging (*pack an overnight bag*); dinner is on your own this evening.

Sept 22 Enjoy breakfast, then check out and travel to the Killington/Rutland, VT area with stops for rest and lunch on your own along the way. Upon arrival you will check into your lodging for a two-night stay. **Dinner** has been arranged for you this evening, along with **live entertainment**.

Sept 23 Breakfast at the inn, then depart with your local guide for a day of touring in Vermont. Your first stop will be at **Quechee Gorge**, Vermont's "Little Grand Canyon" for a photo stop. Continue to the quaint, charming town of **Woodstock** to enjoy lunch on your own and free time for visiting the shops. You will also visit the **Covered Bridge**. In the afternoon, you will depart for Plymouth, VT to visit the **Coolidge Birthplace & Homestead** where our 30th president was born and raised. Visit the Historical Museum, the Carriage Barn, General Store, Summer White House, Church and Plymouth Cheese Factory during your visit to Plymouth. After your visit, you will depart for the **Green Mountain Sugarhouse**, a family-owned sugarhouse, where you will learn how their maple syrup is made and taste the different grades. You may also visit the gift shop. After your day of touring, you will arrive for a delicious **dinner** at an area restaurant before returning to your hotel for a restful evening.

Sept 24 Following breakfast, check out and depart with your local guide for another day of touring as you head towards New Hampshire. Travel to Bath, NH to visit the **Covered Bridge** for a photo opportunity. Continue to the town of **Littleton** for lunch on your own and free time to visit the shops. This afternoon you will visit **Chutters General Store** with the world's longest candy counter. Later, you will visit **The Basin** for a short nature walk on a paved path where you will see the natural rock pot hole in the shape of a basin. Continue to Lincoln, NH for the **Loon Mountain Gondola Ride** which will take you to the top of the mountain for spectacular views. (*Please note if Loon is not open, the NH Wildlife program will be substituted.*) After your ride, bid farewell to your Vermont guide as you continue traveling into New Hampshire. Arrive at the **Winnipesaukee Scenic Railroad** to depart on a **train ride, with Roast Turkey Dinner**, along the shores of Lake Winnipesaukee. Afterwards, you will travel to your hotel in the Gilford/Plymouth/Waterville Valley area to check in for a relaxing evening.

Sept 25 Enjoy breakfast, then check out and depart for Maine where you will meet your local guide for a **tour of Kennebunkport**. Learn about this popular summer resort town as you drive by the Bush Family's summer home and several of the sea captains' mansions. Enjoy lunch on your own and free time in Downtown Kennebunkport's **Dock Square**. Bid farewell to your guide as you depart for Freeport, ME to visit the **L.L. Bean Flagship Store**, known for quality outdoor gear, apparel, and footwear. Later, you will travel to Portland to check into your hotel for a two-night stay and delicious "**Downeast Lobster Bake**.

Sept 26 After breakfast, depart with your local guide for a **tour of Portland**. Learn about Portland's diverse history and architecture. See the Victoria Mansion, home of Henry Wadsworth Longfellow, and the bustling Old Port. Stop for photos at **Portland Harbor Lighthouse**. View an outdoor diorama and sculpture of the Bow of a Liberty Ship. The area was home to two gigantic shipyards during WWII where liberty ships were built. You may also visit the South Portland Historical Society building that has a small exhibit area and gift shop. Afterwards, you will enjoy lunch on your own and free time for exploring in **Portland's Old Port**. This afternoon, you will enjoy a **narrated scenic Boat Cruise of the Inner Casco Bay** which takes you past lovely island cottages on the shorelines of Little and Great Diamond Island and Peaks Island. The vessel has indoor and outdoor seating; dressing in layers is recommended. Following your cruise, depart for another delicious **dinner** at a popular restaurant in the area before returning to your hotel for a restful evening.

Sept 27 Enjoy breakfast, then check out and depart for your overnight lodging stop (*pack an overnight bag*); dinner is on your own this evening.

Sept 28 After breakfast, check out and depart for home with lasting memories of the Best of Northern New England.
